8:00a-5:00p	Stifle exploratory - approach to the joint; exposure of the intra-articular structures; transect the cranial cruciate ligament, meniscus exposure and manipulation; medial menisectomy Extracapsular fixation for ruptured ACL Medial patellar luxation repair - joint exposure, trocheloplasty, tibial tuberosity transplantation, joint capsule and fascial imbrication/release Femoral head and neck ostectomy - craniolateral approach to the hip; transect round ligament and luxate the hip; excise femoral head and neck and critique ostectomy
